CHARLESTON – West Virginia Retirement Plus, the public employees' 457 deferred compensation plan administered by State Treasurer John Perdue, has reached more than 11,000 total participants and experienced a \$40 million increase in net assets.

New enrollments for the calendar year 2010 number more than 1,600. Total assets now weigh in at \$107.6 million, a \$40 million increase since the Treasurer took over the plan in July 2006. The plan also boasts a one-year portfolio return of 21 percent, from January 2010 to January 2011.
